2. We are praying for the Lord's provision to complete an elementary classroom building, desperately needed by the Fall of 2006.
3. Support for teacher's salaries as school starts again, area students cannot pay sufficient fees to cover expenses.
4. Stability and increased security in all areas of Haiti so outreaches can move forward
5. School starts in the next month; be praying for area families as they seek to meet the needs of their children.
